From 25th of August, 7am and 7pm - Monday to Sunday.

On the 25th August, traffic management measures are being implemented on the north quays at Bachelors Walk and on the South Quays on Burgh Quay and Aston Quay. These changes consist of road marking and signage changes. All other routes on the quays and all other routes in the city remain the same and North-South, South-North access to all Liffey Bridges will remain the same. If you choose to use a public car park, please ensure you receive your payment receipt after leaving the car park.

Aston Quay

Cars and delivery vehicles

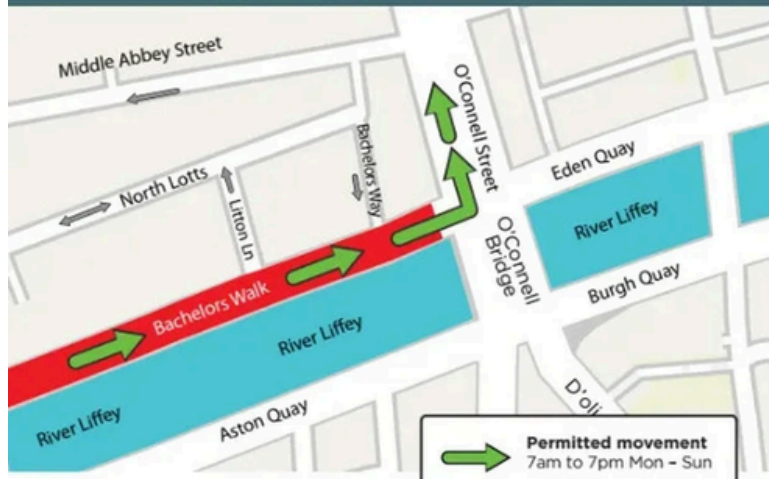


- The changes on the South Quays commence on Burgh Quay. There are no changes before this area.
- Cars and delivery vehicles can travel along Burgh Quay and then right onto O'Connell Bridge or left onto D'Olier Street.
- There will be no straight ahead permitted between Burgh Quay and Aston Quay for cars and delivery vans, 7am to 7pm Mon - Sun.
- There will be no left turn between Westmoreland Street and Aston Quay for cars and delivery vans, 7am to 7pm Mon - Sun.
- Between 7am and 7pm only buses, taxis and cyclists can travel between Burgh Quay and Aston Quay.
- Local Access to Fleet Street (including to private and public car parks) and for deliveries will be permitted.
- The right turn between O'Connell Bridge and Edén Quay will be reinstated for all vehicles (currently public transport and cyclists only).
- The disabled bay and loading space on Aston Quay will remain and are accessible via Fleet Street.
- The taxi spaces on Aston Quay will remain.

Bachelors Walk

Cars and delivery vehicles



- The changes on the North Quays commence after the existing bus gate west of Litton Lane. There are no changes before this area.
- Cars and delivery vehicles will be directed by line markings into the existing left turn lane for O'Connell Street. All cars and delivery vehicles can travel the north quays along Bachelors walk and into O'Connell Street.
- Between 7am and 7pm only buses, taxis and cyclists can travel between Bachelors Walk and Edén Quay.
- The disabled bay, loading and taxi spaces on Bachelors Walk will remain.
